We hope to run the programme with resource inputs from a variety of scholars and researchers, with the aim of both strengthening our domain expertise as well as challenging disciplinary boundaries with a view to transform existing epistemological frameworks from the perspective of gender.

We would like to invite you to share your insights with us keeping in mind certain specific questions: to what extent has an understanding of gender shaped or altered the contours of your research and shaped your disciplinary understanding? Is gender a fact, a description or a process which offers a specific take on reality? Has your use of gender as a conceptual tool or a research method encouraged you to interrogate received and existing frameworks of knowledge? We would look forward to your critical inputs on the topic/s outlined above.

Sessions will start at 9 am every day. Registration of participants starts at 8: 30 am on November 20.

Research scholars working in various areas of Social Sciences may also apply.
